As a result of the Children Act 2004 it is national policy that top tier authority areas should roll out the Common Assessment Framework. This has happened in Gloucestershire over the past four years starting principally within schools and then rolling out to a wider range of agencies.

In April 2008 the Gloucestershire Children and Young People's Partnership adopted the CAF Protocol. Representatives on this Partnership which includes District Councils agreed to begin adopting the protocol by December 2008.

As a result talks have been held with the CAF Lead at the County and discussions have been had with BOD about how CBC can implement the CAF process. BOD noted that there were concerns about capacity and resource implications for implementing CAF. The implications of implementing CAF are being worked through by Officers currently and plans are being put in place for 2009/10 to ensure implementation across the Council. We would hope that the Overview and Scrutiny Review will provide an assessment about how we can best do this, both in terms of our own provision and also how we support other agencies through Partnership working.
