Cheltenham West End Partnership Update

Cheltenham West End Partnership (CWEP) is one of Cheltenham's three regeneration partnerships set up to address issues of multiple deprivation. CWEP's area of benefit covers St Pauls, a large part of St Peters and a small part of Lansdown wards. The area stretches from North Place to the east and The Moors to the west; with its north and south borders being Pittville Park and St James' Square respectively.

CWEP is a company limited by guarantee set up as part of the exit strategy for the Lower High Street Single Regeneration Budget Programme in the 1990's.

Funding for the partnership comes, in the main, from renting out space in the Community Resource Centre in the Lower High Street and the building owned by CWEP in Grove Street. Since employing a partnership manager in May 2008 CWEP has been successful in gaining project funding from Cheltenham Borough Council, Cheltenham Strategic partnership and Severn Trent. This has enabled the partnership to develop work with local communities targeting specific areas.

Because, unlike the other two regeneration partnerships in Cheltenham, CWEP does not receive investment funding from either the borough or county councils the capacity of the partnership is limited in terms of resources and is therefore limited to short term projects. CWEP employs a full time partnership manager, a ten hour per week project worker and it funds Cheltenham VCA to provide reception for the Resource Centre. Volunteers and university students on placement complete the workforce.

CWEP does have an action plan for 2009/10 based on priority areas of work. A Report against this action plan follows.
