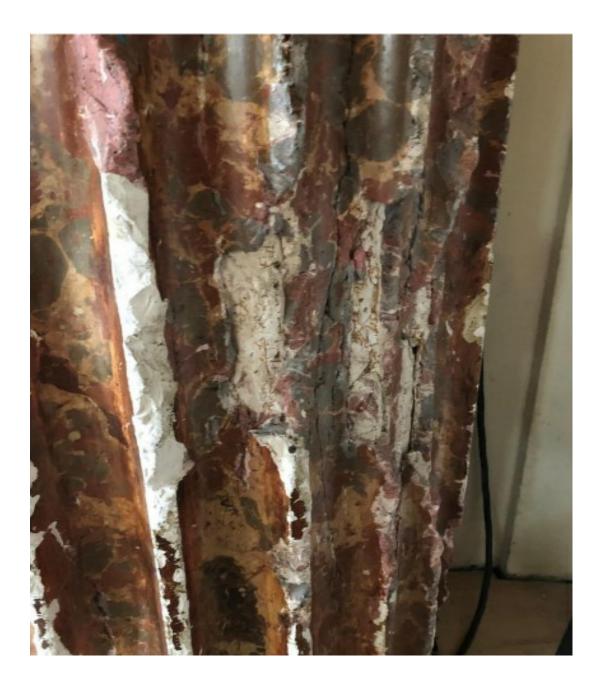


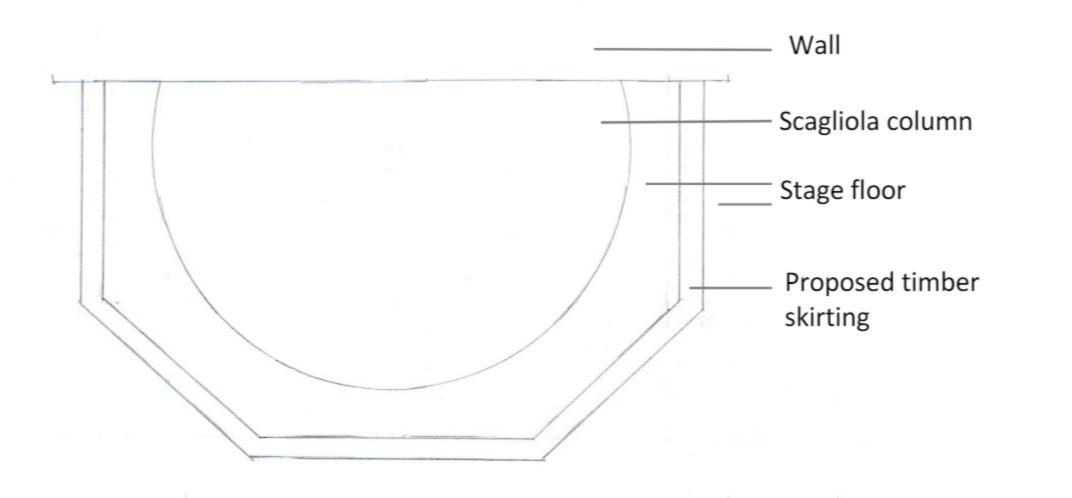




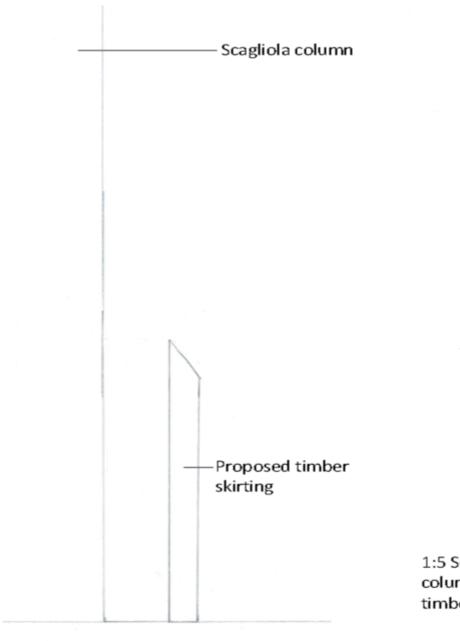








1:10 scale plan of column and proposed skirting. November 2022.

The application is at Planning Committee at the request of Councillor Baker due to the prominence of the site and is of significant interest.

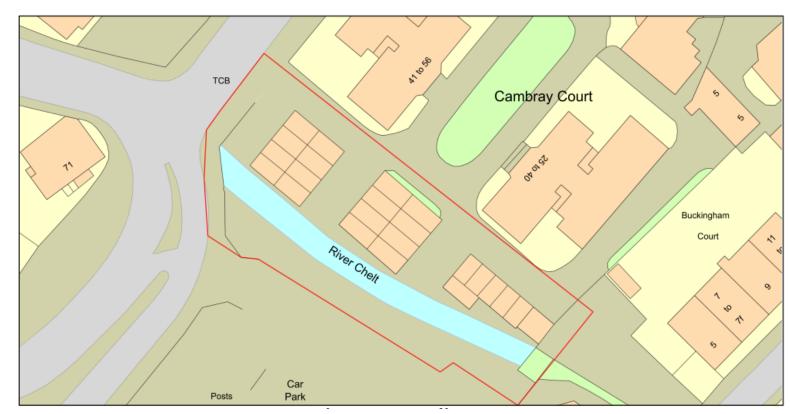

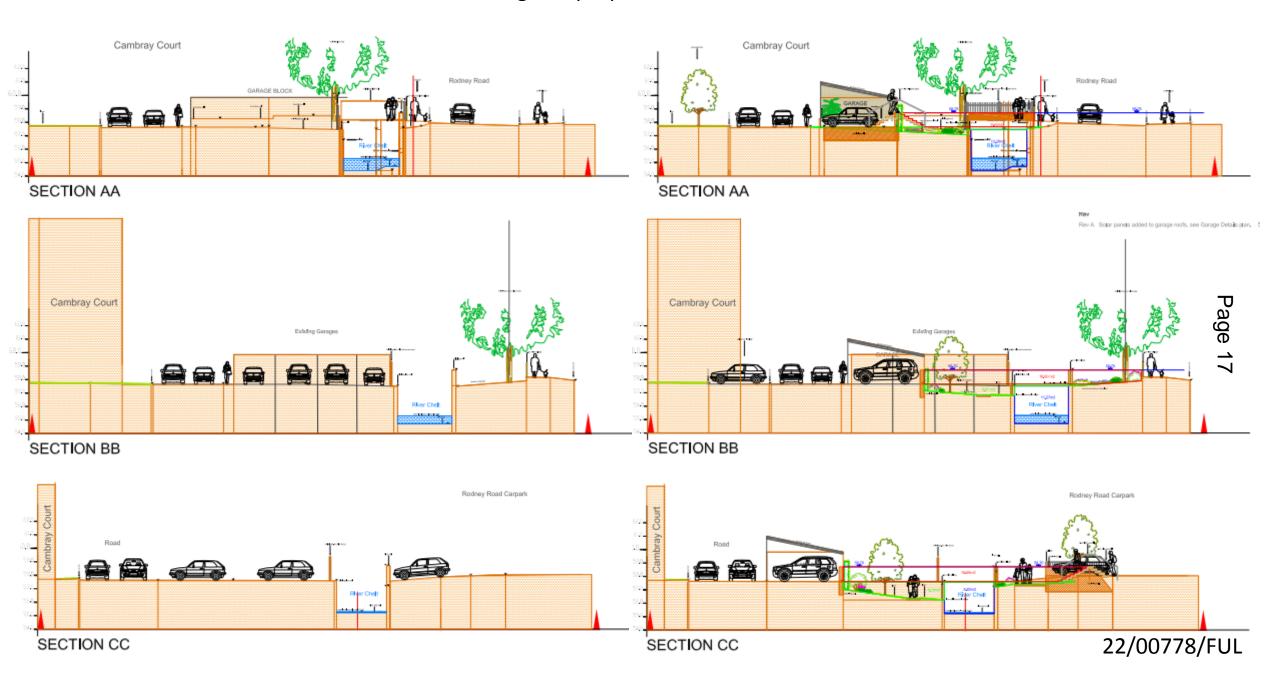


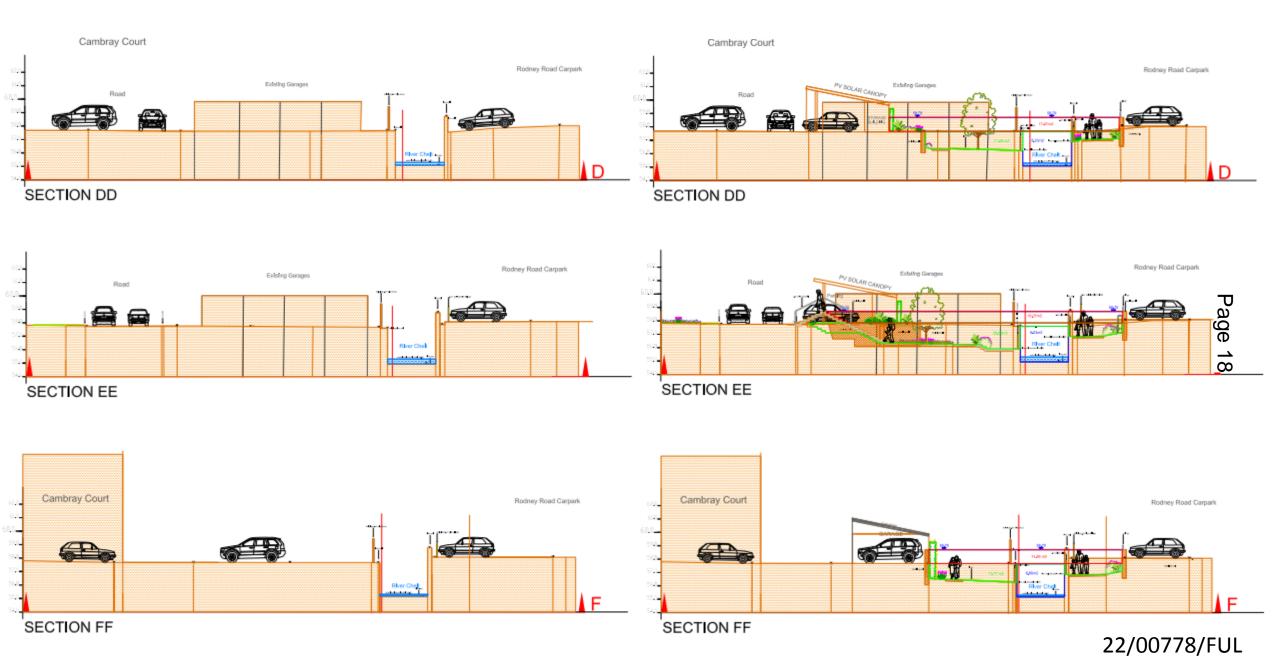


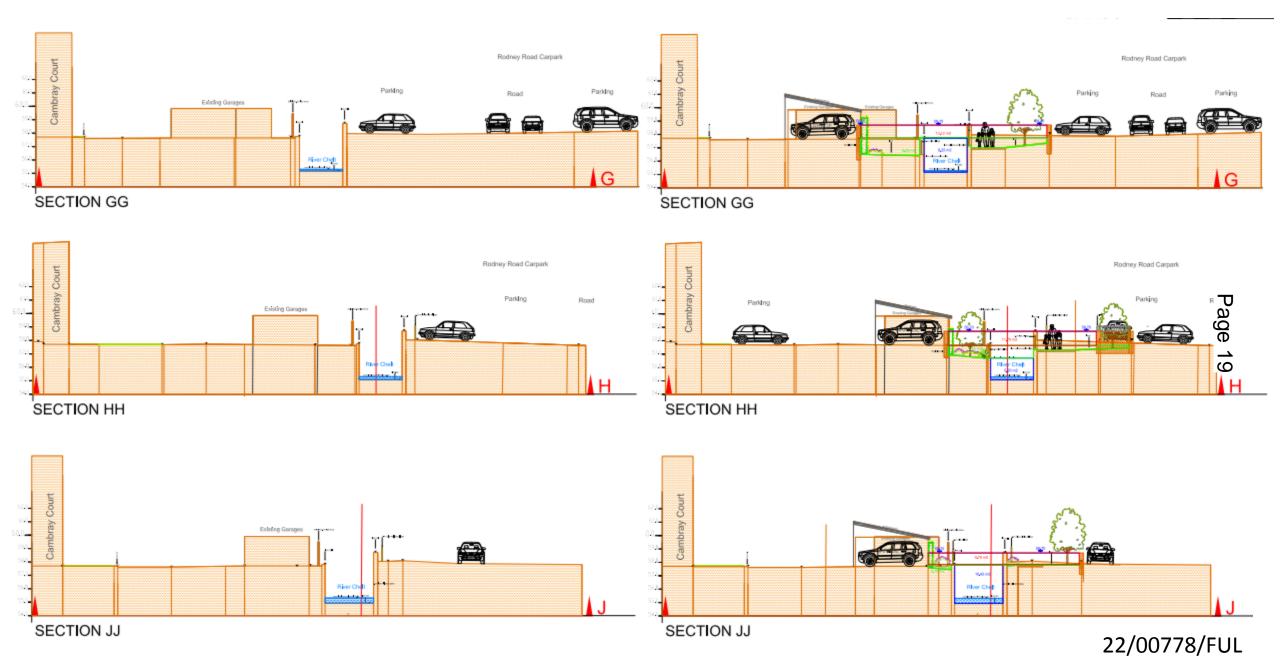


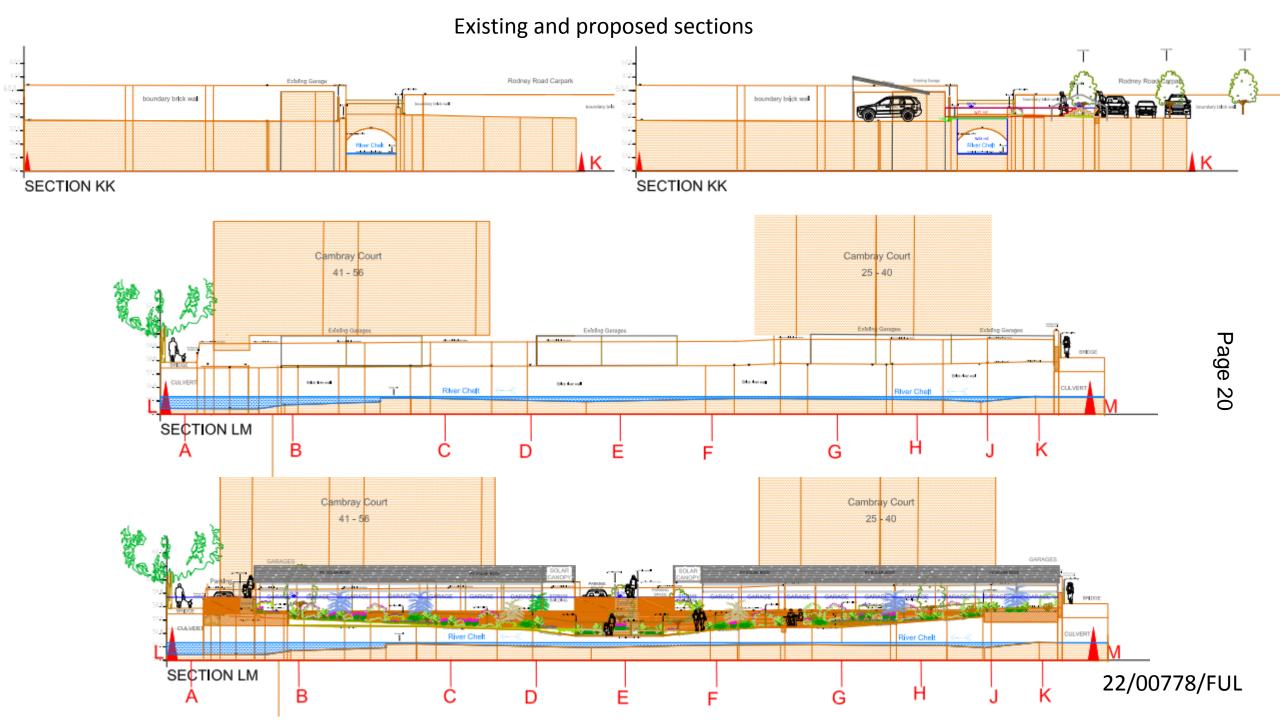
Proposed site layout

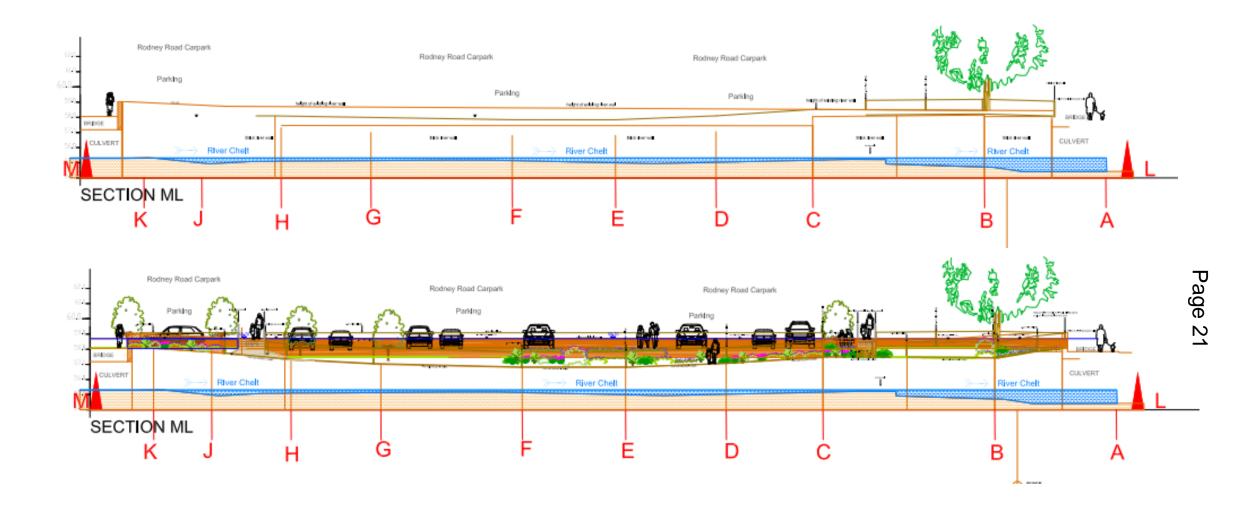

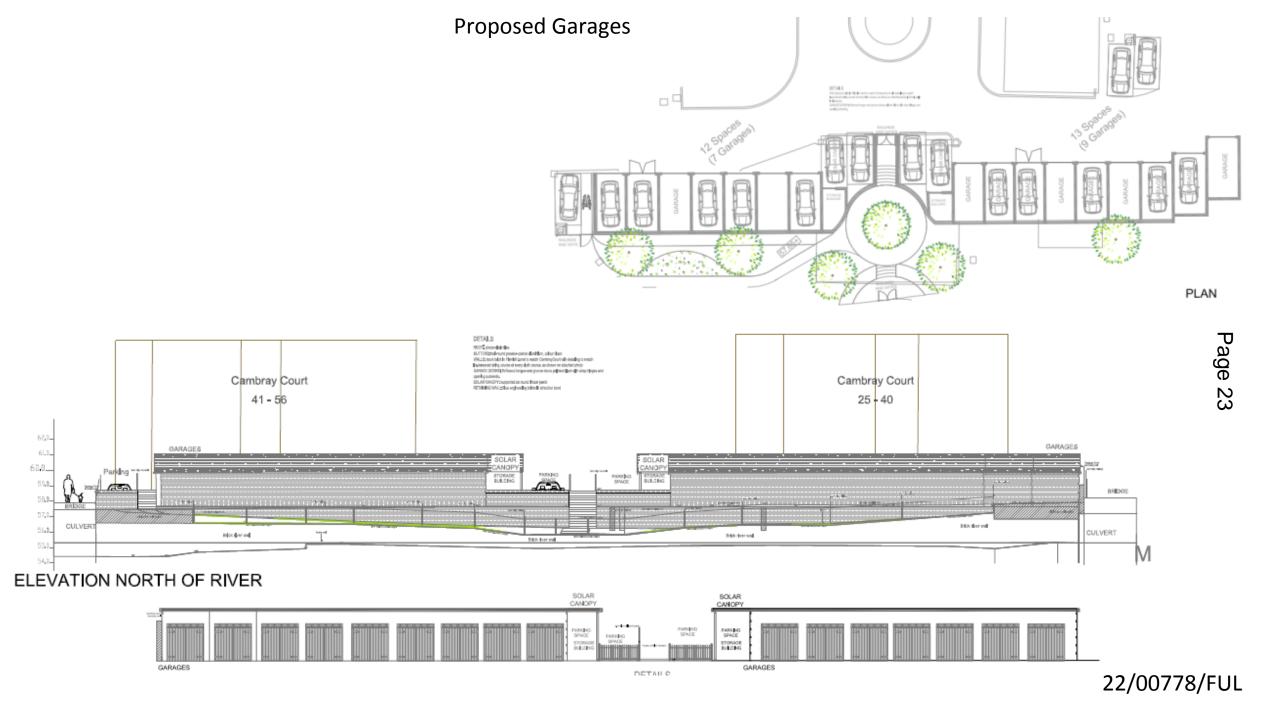


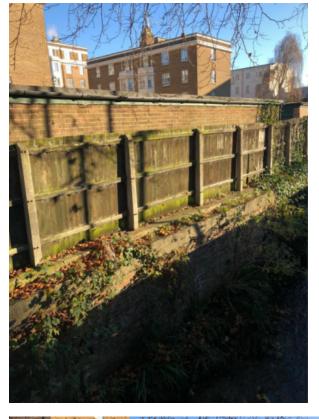


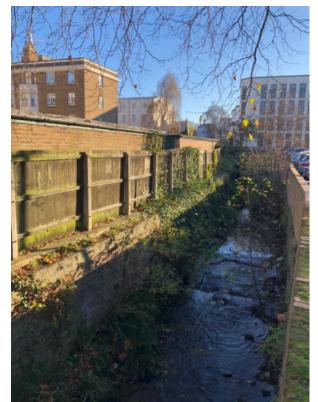
Existing Site Plan

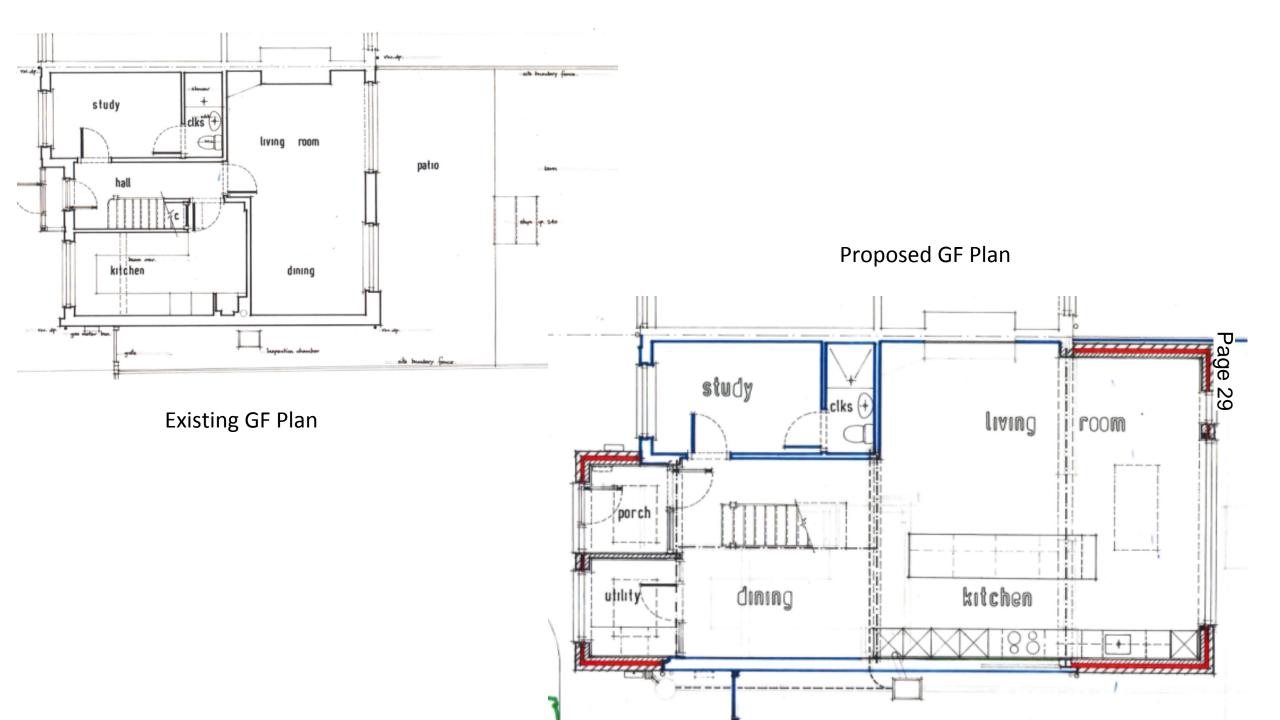
