

Live Music Description

The aim is to promote acoustic, soft background style musicians. For example, musicians playing (acoustic country). The applicant has stated: "The main point of applying for the live music part of the licence was to really incorporate the 'community' aim of our business into every aspect. The concept they are looking to achieve is customers eating some small plates of local food, on ceramics made by their in-house Cheltenham based ceramicist listening to a local young performer."

Police Conditions agreed and added to the operating schedule during the consultation period Prevention of crime and disorder

- a) A CCTV system will be in operation at the premises covering any entrance / exit and all licensable areas. Recorded images shall be retained for a minimum period of 28 days (14 days for digital systems). The CCTV system shall be maintained in good working order, shall record at all times the premises are open. CCTV images will be provided to the police and other responsible authorities if requested as soon as practicable.
- b) The correct time and date will be generated onto both the recording and the real time image screen
- c) Any person left in charge of the premises must be trained in the use of any such CCTV equipment, and be able to produce CCTV images to an officer from a responsible authority upon request.
- d) An Incident book indicating the date, time and description of incident that has taken place shall be kept. The incident book shall be made available for inspection upon the request of a duly authorised officer of the Licensing Authority or Police.
- e) There will be no standing at the bar, or vertical drinking, seated only in all licensable areas.
