Executive summary	<p>Council may confer the title of Honorary Alderman on persons who it considers have rendered eminent services to the Authority in their past roles as councillors.</p> <p>Historically, Council has conferred the title of Honorary Alderman upon its past members in recognition of both long service and significant contribution to the Authority's affairs.</p> <p>The longstanding local criteria which has been applied when conferring the title of Honorary Alderman is that the person has at least 16 years service or is a past Mayor and Chairman of the Council</p> <p>Group Leaders recommend that the title is conferred on the individuals identified below. This will be considered at a special meeting of the Council convened for this purpose which will take place immediately following the scheduled Annual and Selection Council meeting on 2 June 2014.</p>

<p>Legal implications</p>	<p>Council may confer the title of Honorary Alderman on persons who have, in the opinion of Council, rendered eminent services to the Authority as past members of the Authority but who are not then members of the Authority.
