Page 4 Council may confer the title of Honorary Alderman on persons who have, Legal implications in the opinion of Council, rendered eminent services to the Authority as past members of the Authority but who are not then members of the Authority. The Council decision to confer the title must be passed at a meeting specially convened for the purpose and by not less than two-thirds of the members voting thereon. An Honorary Alderman may attend and take part in such civic ceremonies as the Authority may from time to time decide but, as such, has no right to: attend meetings of Council, Cabinet or Committee other than as a member of the public, receive any of the allowances or other payments to which councillors are entitled.
