The redrafting therefore replaces and/or updates the following policies of the draft JCS; S2 – Flood risk management S10 – Green infrastructure S11 – Renewable energy development C5 – community facilities C7 – transport requirements D1 – infrastructure D2 – Assessments D3 – transport Assessments and travel plans
