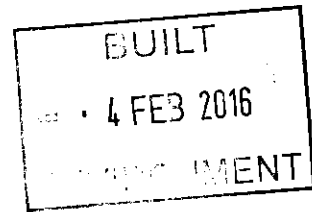

Dear Mrs. Crews,

Application No. 15/02065/FUL - Bmx Track – Burrows Field.

Please find attached a Petition signed by nearly 200 people asking that this application be rejected.

The people who have signed are all regular users of Burrows and/or who live in adjacent roads, which will be affected by the track if agreed.

It has been pointed out on several occasions that in the past, such a track was located at St. Peters, behind St. Benedicts' Church, but went into disuse and was removed . May it be suggested that the background to what happened at St. Peters be investigated.

We repeat, it is considered that we have a well established Youth Centre at Brizen, and such a track, with modifications to suit, would be better placed in such an area amongst other similar facilities provided.

BURROWS FIELD PETITION

December, 2015 - Application : 15/02065/FUL - BURROWS FIELD PETITION

This has been signed ONLY by people who have NOT already signed the "On line" Petition, WHO LIVE CLOSE TO THE AREA OR WHO USE THE FIELD ON A REGULAR BASIS and who will be daily affected by the proposed Bmx Track. The Petition requests that the application for the Track at Burrows is strongly rejected.

1) The structure of the Bmx track at its highest is 2m, and some 75m x 20 m, so it will stand out against the background of the beautiful trees, green field with the background of Leckhampton Hill like a carbuncle, and totally out of keeping with the rest of Burrows Field. It will scar the view from every part of the field.

2) Parking provision at Burrows is very limited especially on match days, creating havoc along the adjacent roads, Moorend Grove, Peregrine Road, Arden Road and Charnwood Road, with cars parked on all corners and on pavements. Additionally, emergency vehicles have already experienced difficulties getting into Burrows on occasions. Tumbles will happen with such a track, and patients would have to be stretchered across the field as the bar across the field is permanently locked, unless opened by a CBC employee.

3) There are no toilet facilities – except for the footballers and cricketers during limited times. With such a track, in use all day, during the Summer months, toilet and some limited refreshment facilities should be made available.

4) Burrows Field is a very wet area in the winter months and the proposed site is in the worst area. Although a bye-law exists to prohibit cycling across the grass to protect both the football and cricket pitches, youngsters will completely ignore any written notices and without CONSTANT SUPERVISION, (year on year, not just initially) the present pitches will quickly be made unfit for purpose. We see no way to ensure their protection

5) Some years ago a loose weather proof footpath was put down from the Burrows Field gate to the top of the field, this was soon covered in mud and has since disappeared.

6) Burrows is used extensively for people walking with their dogs off leads, as they have done without challenge for many years and we foresee frequent problems with people, cyclist and dogs getting entangled as the cyclists will not keep to any footpath, with no supervision. This will create altercations between one set of users and another. Present users fear that this will lead to an increase in anti-social behavior, particularly in the Summertime.

7) If a Bmx track were sited in Burrows, it will mean at least two of the present seating areas extensively used by the elderly will be situated too close to the track, so in effect, unusable when the track is being used. This consideration seems to have been completely lost.

8) Very importantly, Inspector Clark in his recent walkabout commented on the tranquility of Lotts Meadow, which will be severely degraded on that part of the Meadow with the proposed track location.

9) The majority of the local people of Leckhampton, look upon this field as of intrinsic value to them, for its tranquility – and its outstanding views to our own Leckhampton Hill. This last reason alone, should protect this Field from the intrusion of any such track. Also despite assurances to the contrary, many fear that our bats will be permanently frightened from their roosts at the top end of the Field.

10) The present users of Burrows Field consider that a track should be provided for young local users but that Burrows Field is just not fit for this purpose. An alternative place such as Brizen Youth Centre with toilets, possible refreshment facilities hard standing and easy access for emergency vehicles; would be better suited, and encourage more use of the existing Youth Centre, where an increase in membership would be welcomed. It is hoped that a further proposal for a Bmx track at an alternative site will be forthcoming.
