Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

- 1 No retail sale of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
 - (c) Every retail sale of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence
- 2 In accordance with Schedule 8 paragraph 6(6) and (8) the embedded conditions and restrictions which apply to the existing licence(s) are preserved in this licence:-
 - a) i) Substantial food and non-intoxicating beverages (including drinking water) shall be available during licensing hours in all parts of the premise where liquor is sold.
 - ii) Suitable beverages other than intoxicating liquor (including drinking water) shall be equally available for consumption with or otherwise as an ancillary to meals in the licensed premises
 - b) Recorded music is permitted by virtue of s.182 of the Licensing Act 1964
 - c) Late night refreshment beyond 23.00 hours is permitted by the virtue of the Late Night Refreshment Houses Act of 1969

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 1
 - a) The premises shall include Alcohol-free Beer(s) and /or Alcohol-free Cider(s) and /or Alcohol-free Wines(s) and soft drinks within the Drinks List
 - b) The "Challenge 21 scheme shall be adopted so that any customer attempting to purchase alcohol who appear to be under the age of 21 shall be asked for an accredited photographic proof of their age (eg passport, photo driving licence, or PASS approved card) and a sale shall not be made unless this evidence is produced.
 - c) All staff working at the premises shall be made fully aware of the four licensing objectives.
 - d) All staff working at the premises shall support the police & local authorities in any crime prevention initiative.
 - e) Alcohol will only be sold/supplied to persons attending the premises who take advantage of the services supplied.
 - f) No noise disturbance will be made to neighbouring residents. Rowdy customers will not be allowed in the restaurant as this will also affect the reputation.
 - g) No children will be admitted after 22:00 hours.
