Condition Assessment of Clock G 1963.204, conducted by Preventive Conservator Annik Brown, Cheltenham Art Gallery & Museum 2011

The clock, which consists of 3 components (as the museum records indicate) were assessed:

Long chain Short chain Clock dial/mechanism H 25cm, W 16.6cm, D 12.7cm

The condition assessment document is formed from a series of detailed digital photographs of the clock in order to demonstrate the present condition.

The Condition spectrum is formed by 3 standard conservation categories Good, indicating no conservation treatment is required at present if current preventive measures remain. Fair, indicating that some remedial conservation treatment is required to stabilise object. Poor, indicating that immediate conservation treatment is required to stabilise object.

The clock is currently in the category: GOOD
