Re-imagined Quadrangle plaza design approved

A design proposal for a new plaza space at the Quadrangle that will improve the relationship between the 1970s landmark and Imperial Square Gardens has been approved by Cheltenham Borough Council.

Following a planning committee meeting on Thursday 19 September, the design was unanimously approved with one member commenting they were 'really excited by these plans to enhance the town centre.'

**31ST OCTOBER 2019****Work progressing on Quadrangle refurbishment**

The site is now fully set up with the external envelope and inner courtyard scaffolding nearly complete and low-level hoardings in place. Protective sheeting is also being added to the scaffolding to ensure work can continue whatever the weather conditions.

Main contractors, Beard Construction, have an on-site project team overseeing the refurbishment work, while the required demolition work has also begun. This has so far been focused on the inside of the building, but work will start on dismantling the roof next month in preparation for the addition of a new fifth storey to house the rooftop restaurant.
