We object strongly against this going ahead. We are a residential household just a couple of doors away from 2 Crescent Terrace. This is a residential and office neighbourhood and having a wine bar as a close neighbour is something that would be disruptive to all who live here. We have 6 children in our family and my husband and I both have jobs in the community that require us to have a restful sleep. Having a wine bar close by will inevitably bring rowdy and anti-social behaviour and noise. We are also concerned that our children and their friends would have to encounter this, which isn't appropriate.

Our neighbours live next door to this property and it would be incredibly anti-social if the council were to grant this licence.

We very much hope that you will protect this residential neighbourhood.
