

DISORDER	Pavement Licence trading hours 19:30 to 05:00:
	Regent Street in Cheltenham has over 10 licensed
	establishments and is a very busy street 'a pinch point' with large groups congregating when the NTE is open. It has a high foot fall of drinkers and the main taxi rank is accessed via a cut through from the street.
	There are 2 main nightclubs within the street which will be due to open on June 21 <sup>st</sup> , these both having high amounts of young intoxicated people leaving the clubs in the early hours.
	If the 5am conclusion time for this application is approved, we would have extremely large amounts of intoxicated people exiting the premises at the same time and with the current limited police resources this would place an immense strain on them and there would be a high chance of crime and disorder occurring. This can be negated by keeping the closure time to 03:00hrs.
	The policing 'Street Safe' officers conclude duty at 5am therefore if any disorder was to occur near to 5am there would be less

	officers to respond and assist.
	Pre covid from January 2019 – October 2020 there have been over 30 incidents involving Aquavitae/Club 21. 9 of these were assaults and 11 were ASB or intoxicated and disorderly related. There were also 3 incidents involving glasses.  I can provide a detailed redacted report of these incidents if required.
TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANO	Directly opposite the courtyard area of Aquavitae is Ormond Place. This is a residential area and often used by dunk members of the public who urinate within it. The area is included in the general patrols of officers to assist in preventing this public nuisance happening.
	Groups often hang around in the area causing noise, complaints have been made in the past by the local residents to the authorities.
	Reducing the closing time would limit the anti-social behaviour occurring.
