




Figure 2. Old Crematorium and transfer corridor with flat roof.




Figure 3. Flat roof above transfer corridor.




Figure 7. Close up of the existing down pipe on the front elevation of the transfer corridor. The new down pipe will link the gutter to this downpipe.




Figure 11. View of the east elevation of the modern extension of the Transfer Corridor. Note the existing UVPC hopper and downpipes.
