Police objection

Good afternoon all,

I will be objecting to this TEN for 7 Pittville Street, Cheltenham REF 24/00205/TEN on the grounds of concerns under all of the 4 Licensing Objectives: Prevention of crime & disorder, Public safety, Prevention of public nuisance and The protection of children from harm.

It has been made clear in my email audit trail below that I have requested details around the setup of the event and how the applicant will work towards achieving the 4 Licensing Objectives.

I have also explained if I am not satisfied with the answers I would be objecting to the TEN and I have allowed an extra day for a reply to my email sent on 12th February at 08:36hrs, no reply has been received. Today Tuesday 13th March 24 is the final day for me to be able to object.

The applicant has stated they will selling alcohol in pint tumbler glasses and bottles beers, the application is also checked to allow on and off sales.

This is where my main concerns are as Cheltenham town will experience a very high footfall in visitors during this time frame that being the Cheltenham Festival which will see an attendance at the race course of around 60 thousand people per day. Many of these race goers will attend the town already intoxicated and being allowed to take open glass pints or bottled beers away with them to walk around the town would have a high risk of serious crimes being committed.

Glasses containing drinks may be used as weapons and in untoughened form, can cause very serious injuries.

There is also the responsibility on the applicant to understand where these glasses/bottles will be left once finished with, in my experience this is often on peoples walls or smashed on the ground which causes further concerns.

The applicant has not clarified if any personal licence holder(s) will be on site, what type of training will be provided to anyone selling the alcohol or how the actual setup will work. They have marked the application as 5 people being inside at any one time, again I find this hard to believe with the 3-4 staff he will have working etc. and these are some of the questions I required clarification on which has not been forthcoming and based on this I have no option but to object to the TEN.
