

Proposed Order Variation Wording

Public urination and defecation

“A person commits an offence if at any time they urinate and/or defecate without reasonable excuse for doing so on or within Land to which this Order applies¹.”

Loitering and aggressive begging

(1) It is prohibited for a person to loiter or aggressively beg in a manner that causes, or is likely to cause harassment, alarm distress, nuisance or annoyance to any person within the Restricted Area.

(2) If an Authorised Person reasonably suspects that a person has been loitering or aggressively begging within the Restricted Area, an Authorised Person may require that person to leave the Restricted Area.

Illegal encampments and tents

“No person shall camp or sleep overnight, with or without a tent, or use a vehicle, caravan or any other structure for such purpose in the restricted area¹ without the express prior consent of the Council.”

General Provisions

A person who fails without reasonable excuse to comply with a requirement imposed on them by this Order will be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale, or a fixed penalty notice of a maximum of £100.

“Authorised Person” means a person authorised for the purposes of section 63 of the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 by the local authority that made this order.

¹ In this case, the entire borough.
