The Ball Room, Bayshill Lodge – Sale/Supply of Alcohol 8pm – 1.00am


I refer to the recent application and would be grateful if you would take into consideration that the above mentioned premises abuts a residential area. The sale and supply of alcohol up to the early hours of a morning causes immense noise and danger from ~~by~~ the drinkers ~~and~~ the breaking of glass on the roads and pavements alongside.

We, the neighbours, already have days when we are unable to get to sleep due to the music and noise caused by the Soho Bar at the rear of their premises who leave their rear entrance door open. The residential neighbours would not suffer so much deprivation of sleep if the door was kept shut. I have experienced many occasions when I have had to sweep the entrance to Royal Parade Mews, when it is covered in broken glass, in order to get my car out of the Mews and onto the main road.

However it is mostly the noise factor which is my concern. I would be more than grateful if the Licensing Team would restrict the sale and supply of alcohol from between the hours of 8.00pm – 11.00pm. I do believe that the residents are entitled to the quiet enjoyment of their homes and that the commercial properties should be considerate towards this end.
