

I am writing to emphore the above application to fell a three at I Fincheroft Lane.

The tree is an Atlas Cedar. It is already more than 40ft high and can grow up to 60ft. It is a totally unenitable tree (as are most cedars) to have in suburban garden.

The spread of branches is 40 ft, the same width as the shouse, and as it is only 10 ft from the house, light is excluded from every room on that side.

Nothing can grow in the large area under the tree covered by the brancher. There is just a huge brown compet of pine needles and lits of dead grass.
